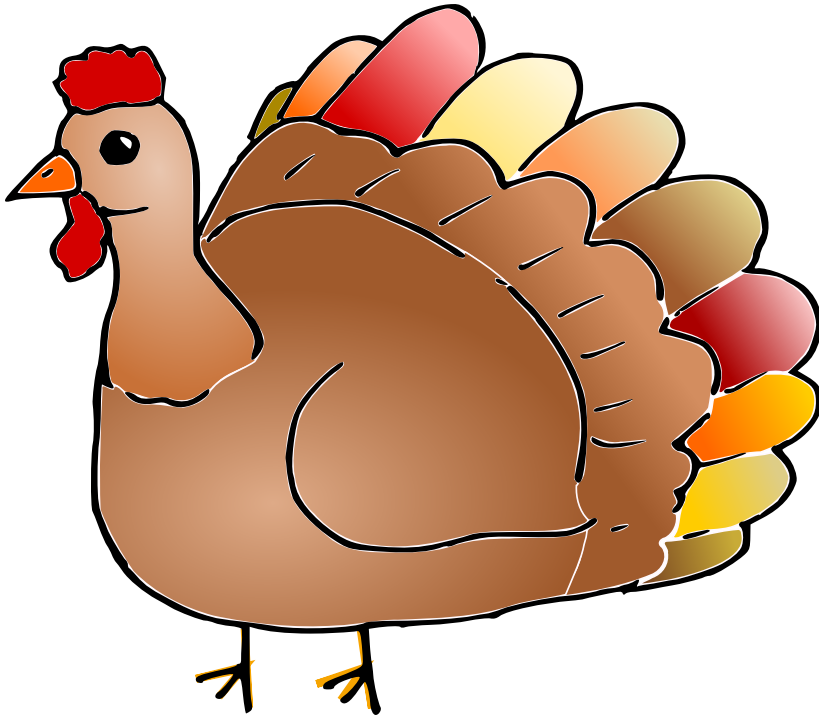
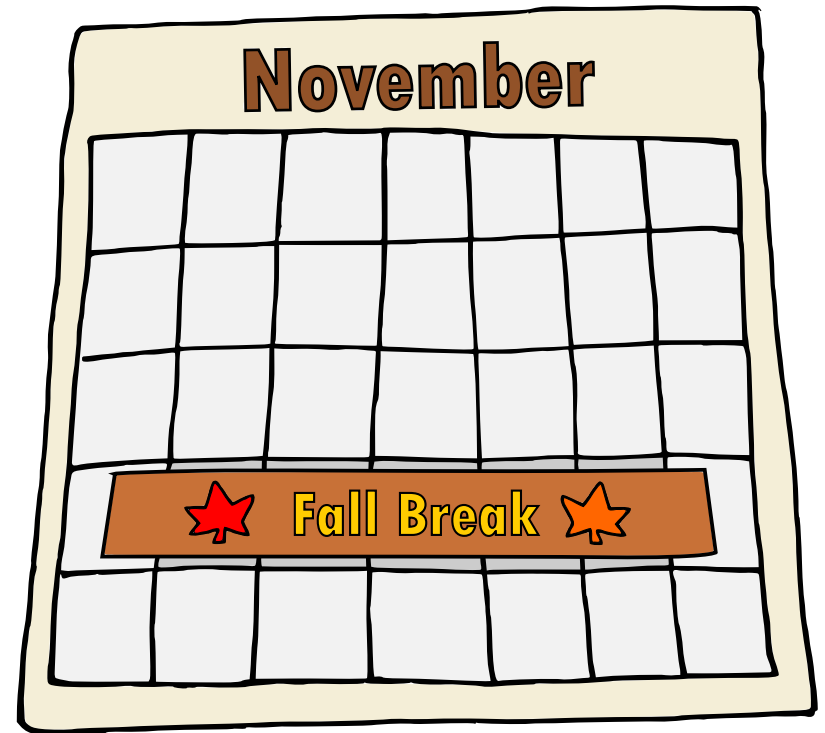


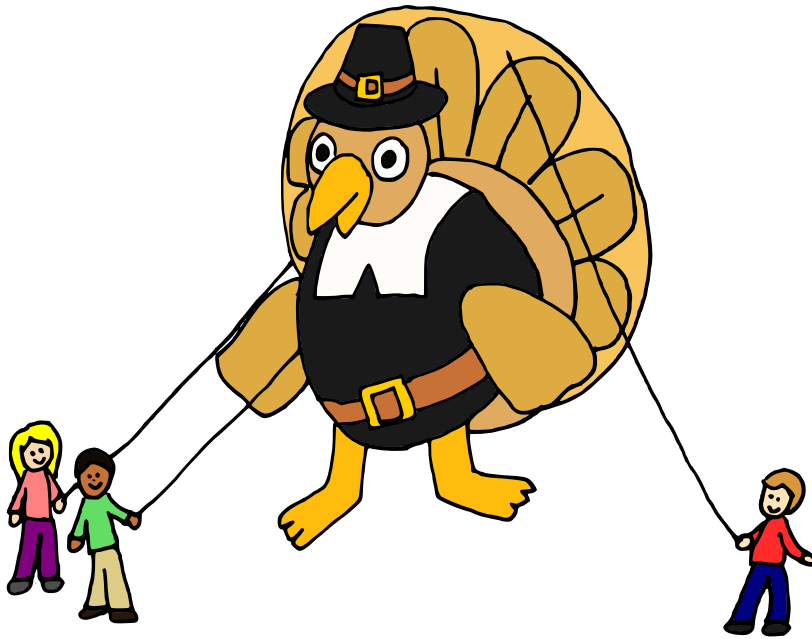
Thanksgiving



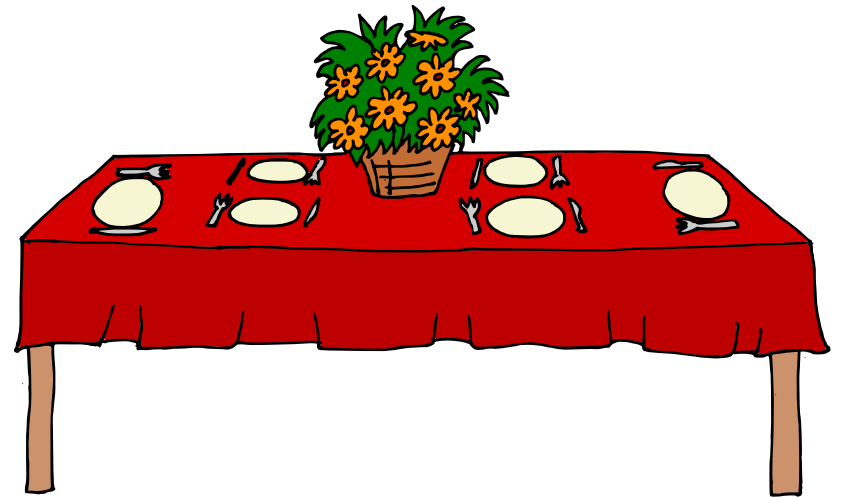
Thanksgiving is coming. That means I will see turkeys everywhere. They will be in the stores, around my school and maybe even decorated in my house.



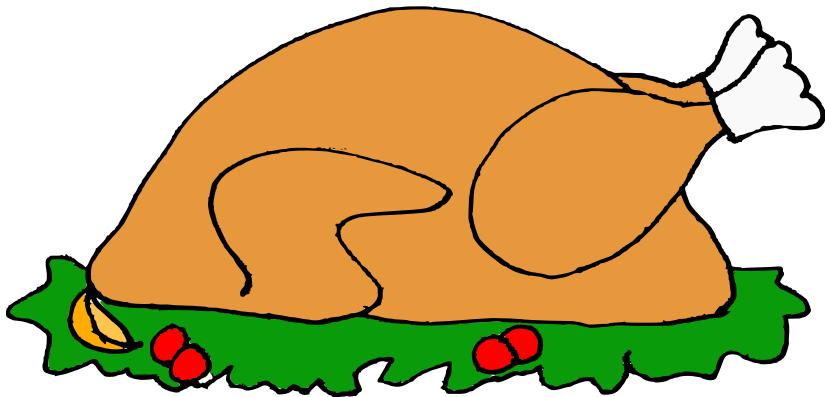
During Thanksgiving, I will get a short break from school so me, my friends and my teachers can enjoy the holiday with our family and friends.



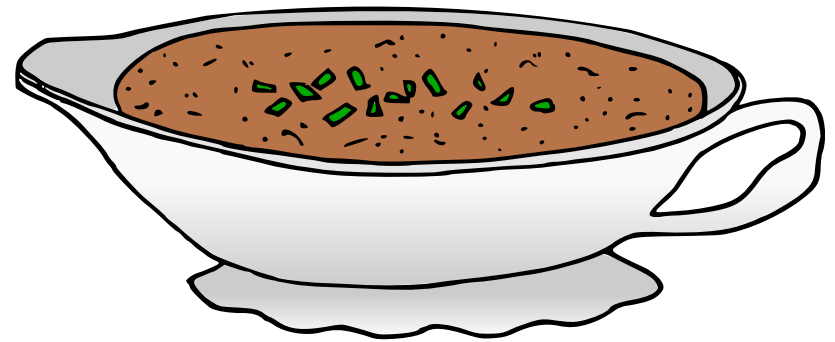
I can watch the Macy's Day Parade on TV on Thanksgiving morning and see huge balloons of my favorite characters.



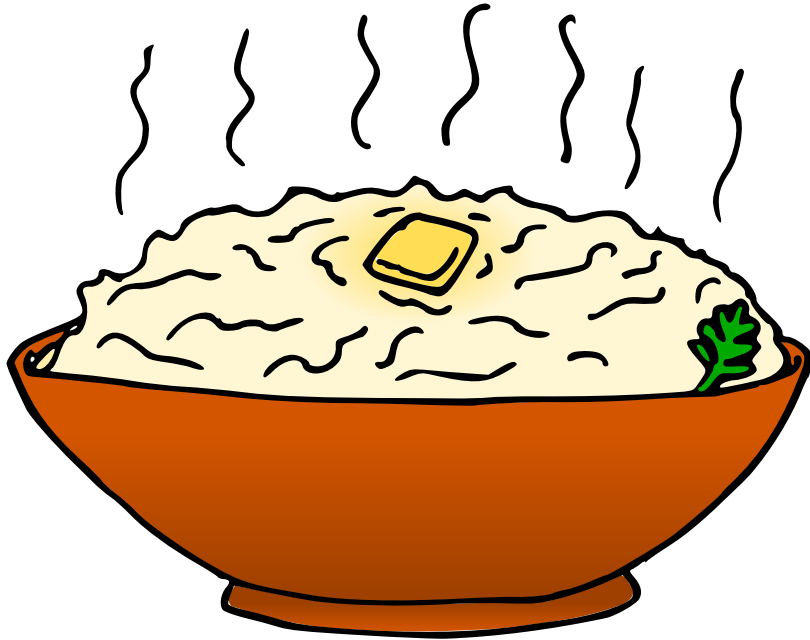

Turkey is called the "main dish" at Thanksgiving. It is served with some foods I might not recognize.



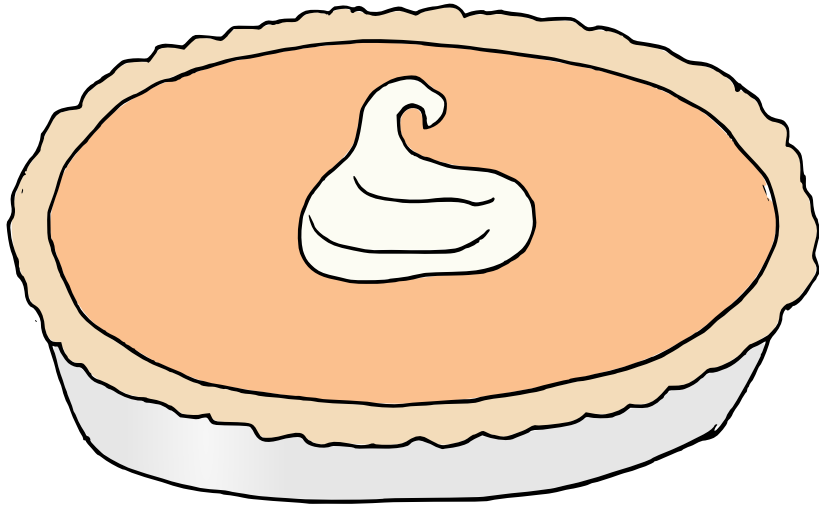
Sometimes people use gravy on their turkey and mashed potatoes.



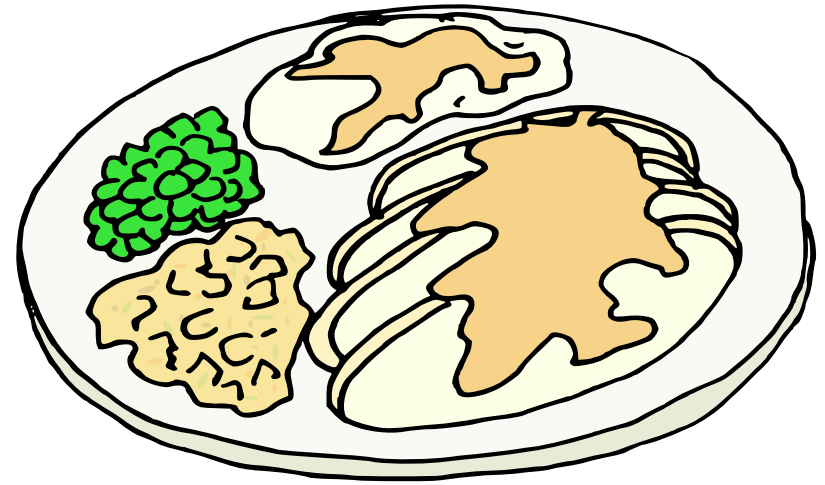
Mashed Potatoes are

that I'm familiar with.



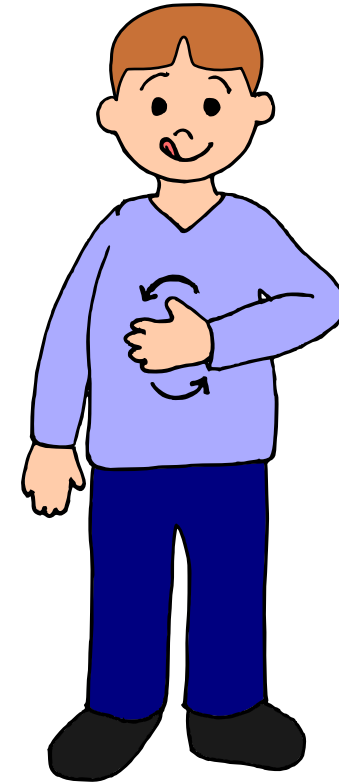
Pumpkin Pie is often served during Thanksgiving. It's orange and sometimes has white whipped cream on top. I can try it even though it has a funny name.
